# ATL PARTNERS



## JUNIOR ACHIEVEMENT OF GEORGIA

Delta supports multiple Junior Achievement of Georgia programs, such as job shadows and simulation experiences. This includes support of JA Finance Park and JA BizTown programs in downtown Atlanta, Gwinnett County, North Georgia and Augusta to provide students with immersive simulations that develop skills needed for today's complex economic environment. Delta also sponsors the Career Exploration Center downtown and the JA Atlanta Business Hall of Fame. Delta's support of JA spans 30 chapters across five continents.

## 3 D E

Delta partners with 3DE to support 13 3DE public schools in the Atlanta area to re-engineer education to better reflect the real world and prepare students for life beyond the classroom walls. This quickly growing program empowers Atlanta students to unlock greater economic opportunity, reducing economic disparities through educational equity. In 2023, The Delta Air Lines Foundation presented Junior Achievement of Georgia with a \$1M grant for the 13 3DE schools across the state.

## YMCA OF METRO ATLANTA

Delta's support of the YMCA extends throughout Metro Atlanta as it aims to help youth across the country build skills and confidence through healthy activity. Each year, Delta teams up with the YMCA of Metro Atlanta in support of Healthy Kids Day, an effort that promotes healthy activity while students are out of school. More than 250 families attend the fun-filled day, which includes play zones, family workout classes, healthy cooking and eating demonstrations, free health screenings and exhibits from other community partners.

## YWCA GREATER ATLANTA

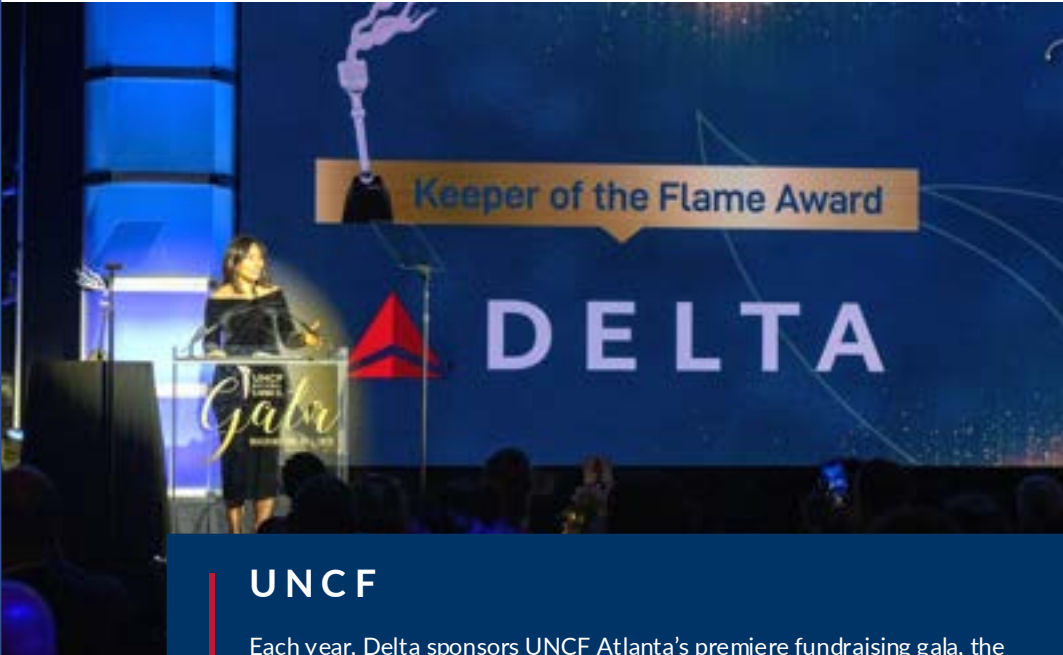

Delta's support of signature Atlanta events include *Salute to Women of Achievement*, which has been elevating women and girls for 120 years, and *CONVERSATIONS*, a forum designed to initiate thought-provoking dialogue and to teach attendees skills that will enable them to promote positive change in their communities. Additionally, The Delta Air Lines Foundation has a \$1M commitment to the Phillis Wheatley Center in Atlanta's Westside community.

Delta proudly supports Historically Black Colleges and Universities in our hometown of Atlanta. In 2022, Delta announced a \$2 million grant for Spelman College's Center for Innovation & the Arts, helping fund the integration of the arts into its STEM education programs for women. ## UNCF

Each year, Delta sponsors UNCF Atlanta's premiere fundraising gala, the Mayor's Masked Ball, focusing on raising awareness of the need and benefits of a college education, the students UNCF serves and the contributions of historically Black colleges and universities. Delta was honored with UNCF's 2023 Keeper of the Flame Award, the organization's most prestigious honor. The award commemorates Delta's dedicated and successful partnership with UNCF that has seen Delta contribute \$7.4 million to UNCF programs specifically benefiting HBCU students.

## AGNES SCOTT COLLEGE

The Delta Air Lines Foundation awarded a \$1 million grant to the Agnes Scott College Global Journeys initiative - part of a four-year experience called SUMMIT that allows all first-year students to engage with the wider world on faculty-led trips across the globe.

## EMORY UNIVERSITY

Delta is proud to partner with Emory University's Goizueta Business School and its Coaching Fellows Program, which aims to provide leadership coaching for Emory MBA students to understand, practice, and enhance their team and individual performance feedback. Additionally, Delta supports critical research to benefit patients and survivors treated at Winship Cancer Institute at Emory University.

## GEORGIA STATE UNIVERSITY FOUNDATION

Developed with Georgia State University, the Delta Analytics Academy gives Atlanta-based Delta employees the opportunity to acquire the skills needed to enter the analytics field, removing traditional education or cost barriers. The three-semester program is a skills-first career growth program that provides frontline employees the opportunity to transition into a corporate career role in analytics.

## SPELMAN COLLEGE

In 2022, Delta announced a \$2 million grant for Spelman College's Center for Innovation & the Arts, helping fund the integration of the arts into its STEM education programs for women.

## MIDDLE GEORGIA STATE UNIVERSITY

Middle Georgia State University is a member Delta's Propel Collegiate Pilot Career Path, which offers a defined, accelerated and customized path for students to reach a Delta Air Lines Flight Deck. In 2023, The Delta Air Lines Foundation awarded a \$3M grant to the university - the largest in institution history - to establish partnerships with K-12 schools, develop satellite flight training locations, procure new equipment and hire faculty.

## ATLANTA PUBLIC SCHOOLS

Delta invests in the wellbeing and educational foundation of students with Atlanta Public Schools (APS) through literacy initiatives and continues to make contributions to Dobbs Elementary School and Hutchinson Elementary School, both near Hartsfield-Jackson Atlanta International Airport.

## UNIVERSITY OF GEORGIA FOUNDATION

The Delta Air Lines Foundation has supported the University of Georgia Foundation for many years. This includes projects involving athletics, such as a \$2.5 million grant for renovating Butts-Mehre Heritage Hall, the athletics administration center that houses the football program, and academic support for programs including a \$5 million grant to Delta Hall in Washington, D.C., the residential center for Washington Semester students, and a \$5 million grant to the Delta Innovation Hub and the Driftmier Engineering Center to foster innovation, entrepreneurship and experiential learning. Most recently, in 2024, The Foundation provided a \$2 million grant to the University's brand-new School of Medicine, with the contribution funding a state-of-the-art simulation center for students.

## CLAYTON COUNTY PUBLIC SCHOOLS

Delta supports Clayton County Public Schools' mission to provide equitable access and experiences for all by providing scholarships to help fund school supplies, fees, rent and AMT certifications among other items. Delta aims to help ensure equitable access to rewarding careers and economic mobility for students, whether with Delta or another organization.

## KIPP METRO ATLANTA SCHOOLS

Delta's partnership with KIPP Metro Atlanta helps support 11 schools in the Atlanta area, helping educate over 5,000 Atlanta students. Delta sponsors KIPP Metro Atlanta's signature fundraising event, "Are You Smarter than a KIPPster?" The funds raised from this event help provide critical programs that support KIPP Metro Atlanta's mission and outcomes. Delta partners with KIPP schools in 10 cities across the U.S. to prepare students with the skills and confidence to pursue the career paths they choose.

## 100 BLACK MEN OF ATLANTA & EMERGING 100

In partnership with 100 Black Men of Atlanta's Emerging 100 program, Delta provides scholarships for Atlanta Public Schools students, sponsors community events and connects employees with local youth to offer mentoring and expose them to careers with Delta.

## TREES ATLANTA

Delta is a seed partner for the Downtown Tree Planting Plan, created by Trees Atlanta and Central Atlanta Progress. This effort aims to increase the tree canopy in downtown Atlanta and address the urban heat island by planting 8,000 trees over 10 years, doubling Atlanta's current tree canopy cover.

## ATLANTA BOTANICAL GARDEN

Delta is a proud Corporate Member of the Atlanta Botanical Garden and a Premium Sponsor of one of Atlanta's most anticipated social events, the Garden of Eden Ball. This support ensures the Garden continues to be an ever-evolving destination where the horticulturally-minded, nature-inspired and fun-seeking families come together to feel human again.

## TRUST FOR PUBLIC LAND

Delta and Trust for Public Land (TPL) partner to provide communities equitable access to quality parks and greenspace. In partnership with TPL and the National Monuments Foundation, The Delta Air Lines Foundation committed \$1 million to radically transform Atlanta's 16-acre Cook Park into a vital urban greenspace. Delta also supports the Community Schoolyards™ program in Atlanta, which transforms schools' blacktop schoolyards into vibrant community hubs.

## PARK PRIDE

Delta is a proud partner of Park Pride, an Atlanta-based nonprofit that engages communities in their neighborhood parks through volunteer projects, community-led park redesigns and other events. Delta people donate their time to Park Pride through volunteer events where they help with trash pick up, trail maintenance, general landscaping, park beautification and other activities.

## CAPTAIN PLANET FOUNDATION

Longtime Delta partner Captain Planet Foundation (CPF) works to engage and empower young people to be problem solvers for the planet. Delta's support of CPF's Project Learning Gardens provides schools in and around Atlanta with outdoor learning laboratories where students engage in inquiry-driven learning.

## DRAWDOWN GEORGIA

Delta is proud to join Drawdown Georgia as it builds a movement to accelerate progress toward net zero greenhouse gas emissions. As a participant in the Drawdown Georgia Compact, Delta engages its employees and stakeholders to inspire social and technological breakthroughs.

## LIVETHRIVE

Delta supports Live Thrive's Center for Hard to Recycle Materials (CHaRM) as a sponsor of their signature fundraiser, A CHaRM'ing Evening, which supports educational initiatives and the operational costs to run CHaRM. CHaRM is Atlanta's only permanent drop-off facility that improves environmental health by encouraging reuse and diverting thousands of pounds of household hazardous waste and other hard-to-recycle items from landfills and water systems. In 2024, Delta was once again named CHaRM Corporate Challenge champions, with employees diverting 28,134 pounds of recycling from landfills over a three-week span in April.

## ATLANTA BUSINESS LEAGUE

Delta sponsors Atlanta Business League's Taking Your Business to the Next Level Program, which helps train Black entrepreneurs to grow and lead successful businesses while making an economic impact in their communities. Delta also helped pay off the mortgage on the organization's building and secure the nonprofit's future.

## CITY OF REFUGE

Together, Delta and City of Refuge are contributing to the restoration and transformation of the Westside of Atlanta by helping individuals and families transition out of crisis. As the presenting sponsor of City of Refuge's Workforce Innovation Hub, Delta is helping individuals achieve economic and financial stability through employment, while also providing opportunities for Delta employees to volunteer and serve as mentors.

## WESTSIDE FUTURE FUND

Delta has partnered with Westside Future Fund since 2015 to help provide affordable housing to the residents of Atlanta's historic Westside, with Delta and The Delta Air Lines Foundation contributing \$20 million and \$5.5 million respectively. By supporting the "Home on the Westside" program, Delta helps residents of Vine City, English Avenue, Ashview Heights and Atlanta University Center continue to live and thrive in these neighborhoods experiencing gentrification. Additionally, Delta is a Champion sponsor of Ride for the Westside, raising funds to ensure the equitable revitalization of the Historic Westside neighborhoods.

## NATIONAL PHILANTHROPY DAY

Hosted by the Association of Fundraising Professionals' Greater Atlanta Chapter, National Philanthropy Day brings together over 800 local leaders throughout Atlanta to celebrate the power of community annually. Delta is the presenting sponsor of National Philanthropy Day's Philanthropic Leader of Tomorrow Award; the 2023 award went to Ryan Wilson, the co-founder and CEO of The Gathering Spot, a private membership network that seeks to close the wealth gap for minorities through community building, entrepreneurship, group economics and wealth building.

## HANDS ON ATLANTA

Delta is proud to partner with Hands on Atlanta, an organization that connects volunteers to nonprofit organizations and schools in need. Delta is the presenting sponsor of Hands On Atlanta Week, an annual event that brings volunteers – including many from Delta – from across the city together to support over 200 projects for over 50 nonprofits and schools to tackle Atlanta's most pressing issues.

## ANDREW J. YOUNG FOUNDATION

Delta has recently contributed over \$2 million to the Andrew J. Young Foundation to support education, leadership and human rights. In honor of the civil rights leader, we recently dedicated the Ambassador Andrew J. Young International Building at our Atlanta headquarters, where all new employees begin their Delta journey.

## OPERATION HOPE

Delta's long-term partnership with Operation HOPE includes our sponsorship of the Global Forum, held in Atlanta, where nearly 5,000 delegates representing 60 countries gather on behalf of empowering poor and underserved communities. Delta also supports Atlanta-based Operation HOPE's One Million Black Business and Entrepreneur Initiative (1MBB), which aims to create 1 million new Black business owners and entrepreneurs by 2030 and help close the wealth gap caused by racial inequality and social injustice. As part of the initiative, Delta people mentor and provide professional advice to Black-owned businesses. In 2024, The Delta Air Lines Foundation committed \$5 million to Operation HOPE over five years to advance economic opportunity, promote financial literacy and help provide equitable access to capital.

## THE KING CENTER

Over our more than 25 years of partnership, Delta and the King Center have collaborated on numerous educational and social change initiatives. Additionally, Delta has invested in upgrades and renovations to the Martin Luther King, Jr. National Historical Park, ensuring it and The King Center can continue to inspire visitors from around the world with Dr. King's legacy.

## JOSEPH & EVELYN LOWERY INSTITUTE

Delta supports The Joseph & Evelyn Lowery Institute with contributions aiding the development of future leaders and "change agents" for civil and human rights. Delta has also been honored to work alongside Dr. Lowery's family to preserve the civil rights leader's personal archives.

## HOSEA HELPS

Through its partnership with Hosea Helps, founded by civil rights leader Rev. Hosea Williams, Delta supports the organization's work to alleviate poverty, hunger and housing insecurity. Delta additionally sponsors the organization's annual Dr. Martin Luther King Jr. Holiday volunteer efforts.

## MARINE TOYS FOR TOTS

Delta contributes resources and funding to Atlanta Toys for Tots annually, with 20 percent of the donation going toward the purchase of books for kids each year. In addition to contributing funding, Delta people volunteer in employee-led toy drives across the system, which generate thousands of new toys for kids each year. In 2024, the 20th year of partnership with the organization, Delta TechOps employees built 1,700 bikes and donated 1,300 new toys to Toys for Tots.

## FOLDS OF HONOR FOUNDATION

Delta serves as a partner in Atlanta and 15 other markets across the U.S. to support the Folds of Honor Foundation in providing educational scholarships to the children and spouses of fallen and disabled service members.

## FISHER HOUSE FOUNDATION

Fisher House Foundation offers a network of comfort homes, located on military bases or next to Veterans Health Administration (VA) hospitals, where families of military personnel can stay at no cost while their loved ones receive treatment. Delta committed \$1 million toward the funding of the future Atlanta Fisher House at the Atlanta VA Medical Center. Additionally, during the SkyMiles SkyWish program's Veteran's Month promotion every November, Delta matches miles donated by SkyMiles Members to Fisher House. These mileage donations go to Fisher House Foundation's Hero Miles program, which covers flights for wounded, injured and ill service members and their families.

## USO OF GEORGIA

Delta partners with the USO of Georgia to sponsor Operation Block Leave each year, which helps troops who are heading home for the holidays. During the holiday exodus each December, nearly 10,000 troops pass through ATL, and each is greeted and cared for by the USO and Delta volunteers.

## AMERICAN RED CROSS

In the Atlanta area, Delta people remain steadfast in their commitment to giving the gift of life through Delta-sponsored blood drives. In FY24, Atlanta hosted dozens of blood drives across many different locations, including the ATL airport, Truist Park, Ponce City Market and Mercedes-Benz Stadium. Nationally, Delta employees, retirees and customers contributed 15,585 units of blood at 373 drives in 83 locations across the country during the 2024 fiscal year (July 2023 – June 2024), allowing Delta to maintain its position as the No. 1 U.S. corporate blood drive sponsor for the seventh consecutive year.

## CHILDREN'S HEALTHCARE OF ATLANTA

The Delta Air Lines Foundation contributed \$5 million to CHOA's Never Settle Campaign to support Hughes Spalding Hospital and the following clinics: Primary Care Clinic, Sickle Cell Disease Clinic, Asthma Clinic, Diabetes Clinic, Behavioral and Mental Health, and Family Support. Delta additionally supports specific CHOA programs to address the clinical needs of kids in underserved areas including social work and behavioral/mental health integrated care at Hughes Spalding, Scrubs Party, Hope and Will Ball, and Delta volunteering initiatives.

## GRADY HEALTH FOUNDATION

A more equitable world isn't possible without basic needs like food and good health. Delta helps provide equitable access to nutritious, affordable food and resources in downtown Atlanta to form healthy eating habits through Grady Health Foundation's Food as Medicine program. Additionally, The Delta Air Lines Foundation contributed a \$2 million grant toward the construction of Grady's Correll Pavilion, a state-of-the-art advanced surgical center adjacent to Grady Memorial Hospital that will offer 25 percent more operating room capacity and 45 percent additional clinic capacity.

## ATLANTA HABITAT FOR HUMANITY

Since 1995, Delta employees have helped build or rehab 287 homes across 13 countries with Habitat for Humanity, including over 50 homes in Atlanta, believing that affordable housing plays a critical role in strong and stable communities. Delta serves as the lead partner for Atlanta Habitat's Browns Mill Village, a new mixed-income community offering affordable housing with community green spaces and recreation areas to residents of south Atlanta; Delta volunteers have built 12 houses at the site. Nationally, Delta has built 12 Habitat for Humanity homes utilizing materials from Delta on-board recycling and TechOps oil recycling programs.

## COVENANT HOUSE GEORGIA

Delta sponsors Covenant House Georgia, as it works to provide housing and supportive services to youth facing homelessness. Each year, Delta employees in ATL participate in Covenant House's Sleep Out, giving up their beds for a night in solidarity with homeless youth. Delta also sponsors Covenant House Georgia's annual Night of Broadway Stars, benefiting youth experiencing homelessness and escaping trafficking. The event provides youth the opportunity to showcase their talents and to share their experience of strength and resilience as they overcome homelessness.

# CELEBRATING 40 YEARS WITH ATLANTA COMMUNITY FOOD BANK



## ATLANTA COMMUNITY FOOD BANK

2024 marked the 40<sup>th</sup> year of partnership between Delta Air Lines and the Atlanta Community Food Bank (ACFB). The ACFB works with more than 700 nonprofit partners to distribute over 8 million meals across metro Atlanta and north Georgia each month; they are also a member of Feeding America, the nation's leading domestic hunger relief charity. At a recent volunteer event, Delta people and SkyMiles® Members spent the morning volunteering at the ACFB, and in select Delta Sky Clubs, where guests were gifted jars of local, metro Atlanta honey from Bee Downtown to take with them to their next destination. By the end of the day, volunteers sorted over 15,000 pounds of potatoes and at least 1,500 jars of honey were given to families served by the ACFB, Delta volunteers and loyal Delta customers. Globally, Delta partners with food banks across three continents to fight food insecurity.



# ATL FUNDRAISERS

## AMERICAN CANCER SOCIETY

2024 saw Delta's 22nd year of partnership with the American Cancer Society, raising over \$20 million during that time through a number of grassroots employee initiatives. Delta's 2024 Relay for Life and Jet Drag events, which raise money for the American Cancer Society, together had over 8,500 participants. Delta employees and customers participate in these and other annual events such as the Wings of Hope Golf Tournament and Hope Ball to support the fight of those battling cancer, and raised a combined total of \$3 million in 2024.

## AMERICAN HEART ASSOCIATION

Hundreds of Delta people across the U.S. contribute towards or participate in the American Heart Association's Heart Walk each September. In 2024, employees across the company raised \$425,000 to support the AHA, the nation's oldest and largest voluntary organization dedicated to fighting heart disease and stroke.

## UNITED WAY

Each year, Delta supports United Way with employee, customer and corporate contributions. Among Delta's senior leaders, there is a 100 percent participation rate in giving to United Way. In 2024, Delta people raised over \$2.4 million for the organization. Delta's legal team hosts an annual United Way fundraiser dinner for over 200 members of law firms that represent Delta worldwide annually, which raises hundreds of thousands of dollars for the organization.



## BREAST CANCER RESEARCH FOUNDATION

Over the past 19 years, Delta has raised \$28 million for the Breast Cancer Research Foundation, funding life-saving research and supporting 112 research projects. In October, 25% of proceeds from all on-board food and beverage purchases are donated to BCRF. To kick off Breast Cancer Awareness Month in October, Delta's iconic Pink Plane carried more than 150 employee breast cancer survivors on the "Breast Cancer One" survivor flight. Employees donned pink onboard the flight from Atlanta to San Diego to celebrate the survivors of a disease that has affected many of them deeply and personally.

Delta is the Official Airline and Founding Partner of the Atlanta Falcons and Atlanta United FC. Sponsorship benefits include a custom community program each year, in-stadium signage, a digital content series with each team, hospitality and a field level entitlement space.

Delta partnership includes being a presented partner of one home game during the football season and branding on coaching staff headsets. Delta is also the presenting partner of multiple women's sports seasons including soccer, volleyball, and basketball.
